



# Workplace Password Malpractice Report 2021

Keper Security surveyed 1,000 employees across the U.S. and found that employees' poor password practices are putting their organizations at risk.

## Employees are using WEAK OR EASILY GUESSED PASSWORDS

- 31%** Use their child's name or birthday
- 34%** Use their significant other's name or birthday
- 37%** Use their employer's name
- 44%** Reuse passwords across personal & work-related accounts

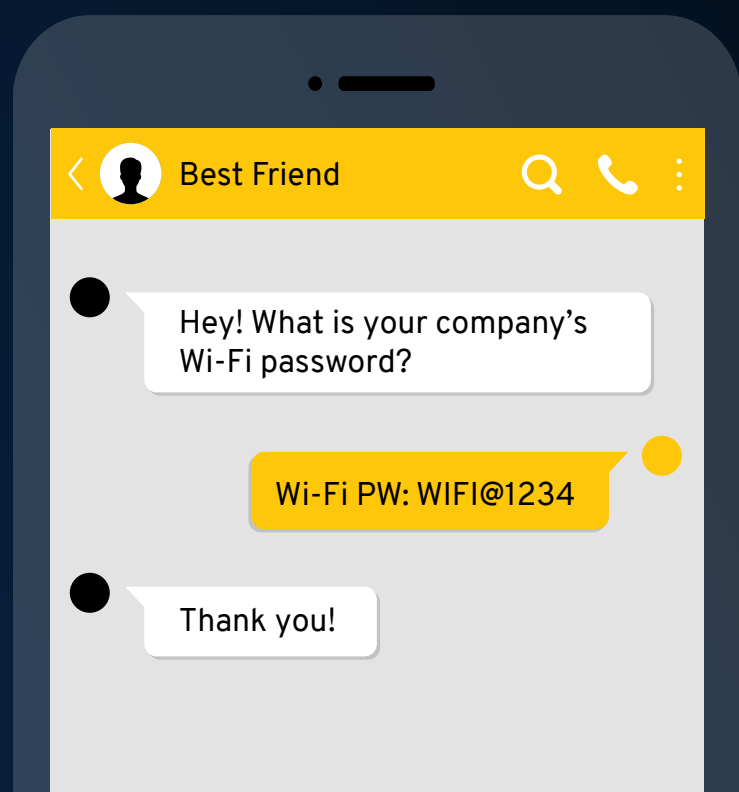
Passwords saved on employees' phones
